## Why do you need RCS certification for items

This certification ensures that the identity of the recycled materials is maintained: from the recycler to the final product.

## Who makes the RCS certificate

The RCS certification is made by an appointed third party who has no business relation with anyone involved in the production chain of the product.

## When is RCS applied to an item?

RCS is the standard used when part of a product, but not the entire product has been made from recycled materials.
