Research some famous vloggers and try to identify what makes them so popular. Learn about the equipment they're using and listen to their helpful advice. Still, try not to copy their vlogs.




Step 2.

Find a suitable location for shooting. Don't be afraid to get creative!



Step 5.

The moment has come to start filming, so relax and be yourself. People can notice when someone is pretending to be someone they're not. Take a deep breath, press record, and smile while talking about what you know.



Step 6.

Don't drag on and speak about insignificant topics just to prolong the video. Say what you had in mind and stop shooting or else you risk being boring.



Step 7.

Post your video online and focus on building relationships with other vloggers. After the first, record another video, it will get easier with each following post. Remember to tag and share your vlog on social media and promote your work on Social Media.
